



DEVELOPING LISTENING SKILLS


DEVELOPING YOUR CHILD'S LISTENING SKILLS IS FUNDAMENTAL FOR READING AND WRITING. BY DEVELOPING THEIR ABILITY TO DISTINGUISH SOUNDS, THEY BECOME MORE ABLE TO HEAR INITIAL SOUNDS IN WORDS, BREAK THE WORDS INTO SOUNDS AND THEN ARE MORE ABLE TO BLEND THEM BACK TOGETHER.



HOW TO PLAY?




