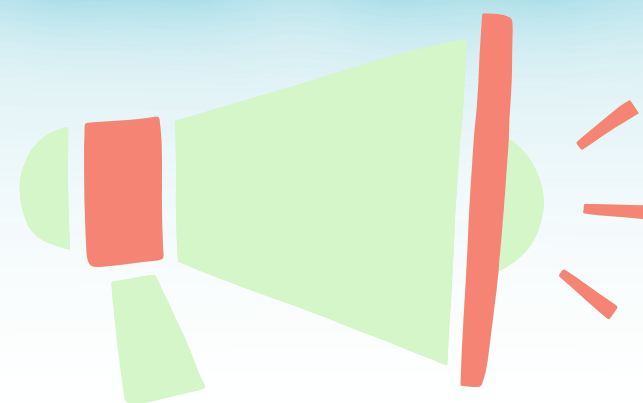

Interview PLANNING

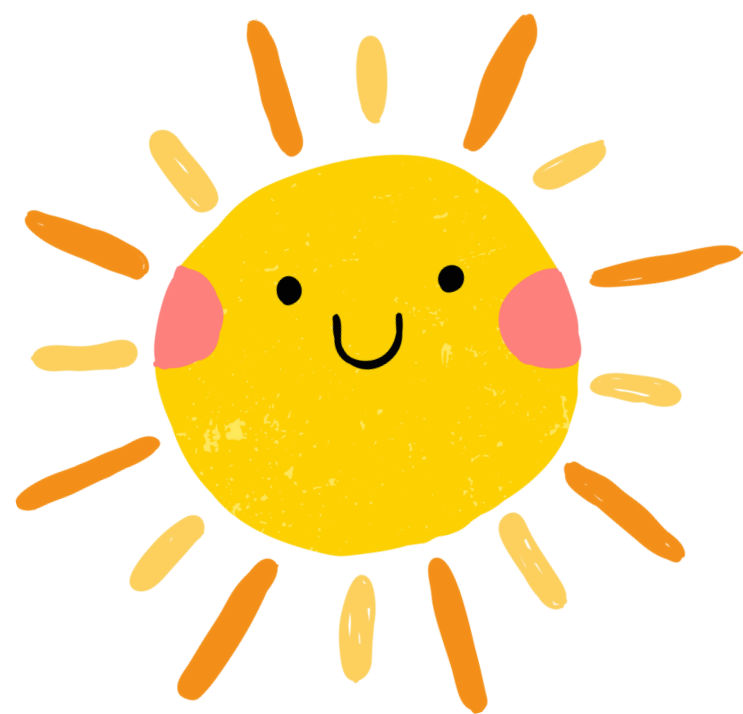


It's important to plan your interviews before recording..

- What would the audience like to know about them?

Make as many notes as you can, it will help you feel prepared for the interview!



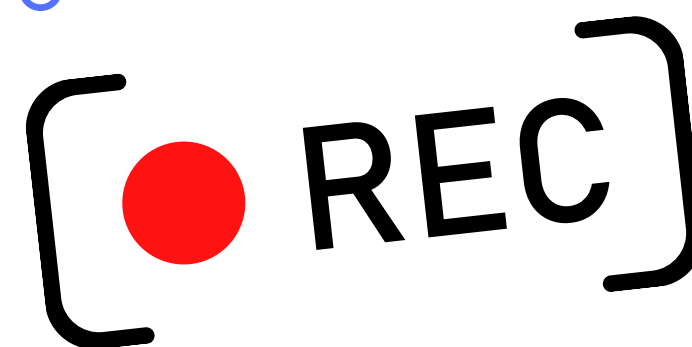
Recording Checklist

Draw your podcast cover – make it really bold and noticeable so people know how to find your podcast quickly!


Have a bold title and a space for a tag line –




